Lodging

You will live anywhere from 5–45 minutes from the IES Center. However, don't worry about transportation costs. You will be provided with a student transportation pass to cover the use of buses, U-Bahns (underground trains), S-Bahns (above-ground trains), and Strassenbahns (bus trams) in Berlin.

Do not expect to have Internet access from your apartment. You may be able to pick up unprotected wireless signals near your apartment, but this is becoming less common.

Labs & Library

IES has a large computer lab with Internet access, Microsoft Office, and other programs that may be needed for classes. However, the computer lab is only open during IES business hours (usually from 9:00 am until 5:00 pm or 7:00 pm, depending on the day of the week). For this reason, you may choose to bring a laptop to do homework and projects from your apartment. IES also provides wireless Internet access for laptops within the office and will assist you with the setup.

IES has a small library of literary and video materials available for class research as well.
